Top tips when job hunting

3 simple steps to find local graduate opportunities.

1 Search and apply online

Visit the University of Huddersfield JobShop where you can search by locality and career type.

Each year we advertise over 1500 grad jobs in the West Yorkshire region.

Job sites like Indeed and Glassdoor can be a useful source, while **LinkedIn** is a great place to look for vacancies. You should make an effort to be following local companies and join groups that are relevant to your career plans.

2 Use local recruitment agencies

These are an important source of opportunities. Remember the agency should charge the company not you, so this is another free service.

In this guide we've picked out examples of recruitment agencies specific to each region. Typically, recruitment agencies have specialisms in certain job sectors, so check which are listed for your region. If you are looking for a career in a sector not listed, search online by combining the place, type of work and include the phrase 'recruitment agency' to see what is suggested.

Prospects is a great resource and has some handy advice on getting the most out of agencies along with links to sites that you can use to find specialist ones.


3 Network and make speculative applications

Some vacancies are never advertised because employers fill them by word-of-mouth or hire people they already know. Because of this, it can be a good idea to speak with your friends and family about what it is you're looking for.

You may find they have a contact that can provide advice or help you to get work experience; or that somebody they know, knows somebody else who could be useful in your job search.

A speculative application is when you contact a company that you are interested in working with speculatively, even though they are not advertising.

Research, persistence and a bit of luck is needed to succeed here. Use our step-by-step guide on making speculative applications on our website, and read TargetJobs advice on speculative applications for graduate jobs.


